**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF KREMMLING,
COLORADO, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2026-07-02 AND TERMINATING THE
STAGE 2 FIRE RESTRICTIONS IMPLEMENTED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 8.22 OF
THE KREMMLING MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.22.030 of the Kremmling Municipal Code, the Mayor or Town Manager is authorized to issue a written order implementing restrictions on Open Burning that are more stringent than standardly set forth in the municipal code; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2026, Mayor Wes Howell issued a Written Administrative Order implementing Stage 2 Fire Restrictions within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Kremmling due to heightened environmental fire risks; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2026, the Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 2026-07-02 ratifying the Mayor's Administrative Order pursuant to Section 8.22.030(C) of the Kremmling Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.22.030(D) of the Kremmling Municipal Code provides that restrictions issued by administrative order shall continue in effect until modified or repealed by resolution of the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, following recent favorable weather changes, reduced fire danger levels, and consultation with local emergency officials and the Kremmling Fire Protection District, the Board of Trustees finds that the heightened fire risks no longer necessitate Stage 2 Fire Restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that rescinding Resolution No. 2026-07-02 and returning open burning regulations to the standard provisions of Chapter 8.22 of the Kremmling Municipal Code is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents, visitors, and businesses of the Town of Kremmling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF KREMMLING, COLORADO:

Section 1. Rescission. The Board of Trustees hereby rescinds Resolution No. 2026-07-02 and terminates the Mayor's Written Administrative Order issued on July 2, 2026. Stage 2 Fire Restrictions within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Kremmling are hereby formally lifted.

Section 2. Return to Municipal Code Provisions. Open burning within the Town of Kremmling shall immediately revert to the standard regulations and exceptions governed by Chapter 8.22 of the Kremmling Municipal Code.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

MAYOR'S AMENDED DECLARATION OF WATERING RESTRICTIONS MODIFIES LEVEL 3 RESTRICTIONS TO PERMIT RESIDENTIAL CAR WASHING EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 9, 2026

To the Citizens and Businesses of the Town of Kremmling:

While the Town of Kremmling continues to manage drought-related water conditions in accordance with Town of Kremmling Ordinance 465, recent evaluations of municipal water usage allow for a minor modification to current restrictions.

In consultation with the Town Manager and Public Works Director, I hereby declare that the Level 3 Watering Restrictions established on March 27, 2026, are AMENDED as follows:

1. Outdoor Watering Schedule:

- No municipal water shall be used for general lawn irrigation.
- Trees, flowers, shrubs, and vegetable gardens may continue to be watered on an every-other-day basis during the hours of **7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.** and **7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.**
 - Properties with an **even** street address number may water on **even-numbered** calendar days.
 - Properties with an **odd** street address number may water on **odd-numbered** calendar days.

2. Residential Car Washing Permitted:

- Washing of personal vehicles at home using municipal water is permitted on your designated odd/even watering day, provided that a hose equipped with an automatic shut-off nozzle is used to prevent unnecessary water loss.

3. Bulk Water Sales Prohibited:

- The Town's Bulk Water Stations remain CLOSED.
- No commercial, industrial, or residential bulk water sales or withdrawals are permitted until further notice.

4. Town Parks & Re-Use Water:

- Town parks and other properties utilizing re-use water may continue lawn irrigation on a limited schedule.

These amended restrictions take effect immediately and will remain in place until further notice. It is the responsibility of each resident and business owner to stay informed of active water restrictions. Failure to comply may result in enforcement penalties as set forth in Ordinance 465. Thank you for your continued patience and partnership in conserving Kremmling's water supply.
